Laurent Perrier, Champagne, France

Laurent-Perrier is celebrated for its particularly fresh, elegant and pure style. A high proportion of Chardonnay and an extended aging period lends the wine its signature finesse and balance. La Cuvée is made entirely from the first, more gentle press to retain purity and aromatics. The wine is aged in cellars for a minimum of four years, creating a delicate and complex Champagne.



Chateau Musar, Bekaa Valley, Lebanon

Founded in 1930 by Gaston Hochar, Chateau Musar first won international acclaim for their 1967 vintage at the Bristol wine fair. Serge, Gaston's son, would be recognised by Decanter magazine as their first 'Man of the Year' in 1984 in recognition of his dedication to producing wine throughout Lebanon's civil war (1975-1990).
